- You must be punctual and have good organisational skills
- You must have a passion for working with children aged 5-14 and be able to interact with children
- Follow policies and procedures and ensure children are under your care at all times
- You must be enthusiastic, confident and be able to apply common sense to all types of situations
- Ensure you always perform to the highest standards to protect the Camp Wild brand
- You will report into the Team Leader/Camp Director as appropriate
- You will have to attend an assessment centre and training day in Chigwell
- You must provide two satisfactory references upon receiving a job offer
